Would your child like an international pen pal?



Deaf Children Australia and the National Deaf Children's Society in the UK are teaming up to offer deaf young people aged 8 to 18 the chance to make new friends and keep in touch.

How does it work?

Your child will be matched with another deaf young person of a similar age, from the UK. They'll get to know each other by exchanging letters through email. All communication goes through our team first to keep everyone safe.

How long does it last?

The project lasts for 8 weeks and your child will have the chance to exchange details with their pen pal at the end.

The project will support your child to:

- make new friends
- feel less isolated and improve their mental wellbeing
- develop their communication skills.
