10 WAYS CLUB STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS CAN HELP DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING KIDS FEEL AT EASE

- > Introduce yourself to the child and family
- > Find out how best to communicate with the child
- > Learn some everyday Auslan signs
- > Have a map of your facilities handy
- > Have copies of your team rules
- > Face the child when you're speaking
- > Make eye contact before you speak
- > Crouch down to the child's eye level
- > Check the child has understood you
- > Have an inclusion statement
