



EYE SPY IN AUSLAN

Go through the books in class. When children are in the playground encourage them to play a game of eye spy - this could be an action word or a noun.

The teacher thinks of an Auslan sign (refer to the Library list available on the web pages)

FOR EXAMPLE:

A short list of some of the words from the books.

Climb up	Slide down
Run fast	Go slow
Grass	Clouds
Sky	Sun

The children then point out or run over to the object/action.

GUESS THE FEELING

Use expressive faces while signing emotion words (see Library), and invite the children to mirror your expression and sign the emotion. The children then guess each other's Sign and expressions.

MAKE A BOOK

Take some photos of things around you at school. Print them out, paste into an exercise book and then add the English word and first letter and learn to sign the word and finger spell the first letter.
