LET'S GO ON A TREASURE HUNT!

Get ready for an adventure at the beach or by open water.

HERE'S HOW TO PLAY:

NATURE'S TREASURES: Look for small seashells, cool driftwood, squishy seaweed, unique small rocks, soft feathers, or interesting pebbles.

WATERSIDE STUFF: Can you spot sunglasses, beach toys, a colourful towel, a funny hat, one lost thong, a big sandcastle, noodles, sunshade or a bucket?

PEOPLE WATCHING FUN: Maybe you can see someone wearing a silly hat, people playing with a ball, someone looking for treasure with a special beeping stick, or a family building a big sandcastle!

COLOURS & SHAPES: Can you find a red seashell? Or a rock shaped like a triangle? Maybe a stick that looks like a letter from the alphabet?

SECRET CLUES! Sometimes, we might even hide a little map or a riddle that leads to a special "treasure" – like a cool shell or a tiny toy!

A SAFE SPOT.

- Choose a safe spot on the beach or by the river, away from big waves, steep banks, piles of driftwood, slippery rocks, or anything dangerous.
- 2. Set a time limit, like "let's find everything before lunchtime!"
- 3. IMPORTANT RULE: Never disturb or take live animals from their homes (like crabs or little fish!). We always respect our open water creature friends.
- Pick a special spot to meet back when the hunt is over!

How to keep track?

MAKE A CHECKLIST: Use a list on a phone to tick off each thing you find.

Picture Time! You can use a phone to take photos of the things on our list.

TREASURE BAGS: We'll bring buckets or bags to put the found treasures in.

HIDDEN MARKERS: Hide clues, and use little flags or painted rocks to show where they are.

LET'S HAVE A BLAST!

Explore and really look at all the amazing things around you.

Learn about colours, shapes, and letters as you go!

Try out the letters, numbers and names of things you find in Auslan.
