1. **Keep your hearing aid dry and cool:**

- Take your hearing aid out when in the shower or swimming and if you are sweating or out in the rain.

- If your hearing aid gets wet, dry it as soon as possible with a tissue, soft cloth or cotton buds.

- Make sure your ears are dry before putting in your hearing aid

- Take your hearing aid off if you use a hairdryer

- Don't leave your hearing aid sitting in the hot sun or near a heater.

2. **Clean hearing aids as instructed.**

3. **Turn hearing aids off when not being used.**

4. **Replace dead batteries immediately.**

5. **Remove hearing aid before using aftershave, hairspray, perfume, sunscreen, insect repellent and so on - they may contain chemicals that could damage it.**

6. **Be careful not to drop your hearing aid.**
